OVER THE RIVER AND THROUGH THE WOODS 2017 SPRING TRAIL RUN

Registration: \$30 Racers, \$25 walkers, \$10 12-under. Includes race, dinner, beanie. All prices increase \$5 4/19, Registration available online until 5/18, in person at the Ore Dock until 7pm 5/19 or until 1:45 day-of at the trailhead, 600 Brickyard Road.

Packet pick-up: May 19th 5-7 PM downstairs at the Ore Dock Brewing Company


On-Site Packet Pick-Up: May 20th, 12-1:45 at Race Start

Race Starts 2pm at the end of Brickyard Road--approximately 600 Brickyard road--in the turn-around

Parking: Drop-off and pick-up only in the turn-around. Parking is available in the south west corner of the Lowe's/Petsmart complex near the temporary "UPLC Parking sign." You can walk from the parking lot less than a half mile (approx. 800 meters) to the end of Brickyard road.

Awards, Dinner, Silent Auction: Upstairs at the Ore Dock! Potluck dinner from 3-5, awards at 4. Silent Auction open from 3-5:30. Prizes given to M/F overall, kids overall, 1st-3rd M/F masters, adult, and kids.

Race Course Description: Race downhill at the start, and then over the river on a footbridge before continuing through the woods while tackling several challenging hills. While you run, you'll pass several signs that detail the unique flora and fauna of the area. Be sure to visit the Reserve again to read them...unless you're a speed reader! The race will take you around a large loop, retrace your steps, and then uphill to the second loop, which will give you an idea of your current standing before the final stretch back to the start--running downhill will help you pick up your pace--but the finish is a steep uphill, so dig in while the spectators cheer you across the finish line. **See course map below.**
